Poster presentations for UKADR Conference 2023

We welcome authors who wish to submit a poster presentation for the conference. Poster presentations provide an excellent opportunity to visually showcase your research findings and engage with conference attendees. Please carefully follow the guidelines outlined below to ensure your submission meets the required specifications:

- 1. Poster Size and Orientation:
 - Poster size should be A1 (594mm x 841mm) in portrait orientation.
 - Ensure that your poster content fits within these dimensions.
- 2. Font and Formatting:
 - Use Arial font throughout your poster for consistency and readability.
 - Main Title: Set the font size to 85 points.
 - Subtitle/Section Titles: Set the font size to 36 points.
 - Body Text: Set the font size to 24 points.
 - Figure Captions: Set the font size to 18 points.
 - Maintain appropriate line spacing to enhance legibility.
- 3. Margin Size and Layout:
 - Leave a suitable margin around the edges of your poster to ensure important content is not cut off. A margin size of approximately 20 mm is recommended.
 - Organize your poster content into logical sections with clear headings and subheadings.
 - Ensure a clear and logical flow of information from top to bottom and left to right.
- 4. Visuals and Graphics:
 - Use high-resolution images, charts, and graphs to support your findings.
 - Ensure that all visuals and graphics are legible and clear at the viewing distance.
 - Label figures and provide concise and informative captions.
- 5. Footer section
 - Please incorporate the mentioned footer at the bottom section of your poster. <u>https://ukadr2023.buildresilience.org/wp-content/uploads/2023/11/UKADR 2023 Poster A1footer-scaled.jpg</u>
- 6. Submission Process:
 - Include your abstract title, authors' names, affiliations, email address and abstract ID in the poster.
 - Please ensure that you hand in your printed poster at the registration desk on the first day of the conference.
